





Hangman Communications Game

Hangman is a simple word guessing game. Players try to figure out an unknown word by guessing letters of the six letter word of the other team. Each time a guess fails another part of the stick man on the gallows is added. Most frequently, the person is drawn in 6 parts (for 6 letter guesses) in the order: head, body, left leg, right leg, right arm, left arm.

If too many letters which do not appear in the word are guessed, the stick man is complete and the player is hanged (and loses).

Split section up into 2 teams of two or two individuals. Each team / Individual is given this laminated sheet and a radio.

Each team / Individual introduces themselves to the other team using the phonetic alphabet. E.g. "My name is Katie – Kilo, Alpha, Tango, India, Echo, Katie, Over". Or "Our team is team Red, Radio Echo, Delta, Red, Over".

Saying "Over" when you are finished speaking is important so that the other side know you are finished speaking.
