



X's and O's – Noughts and Crosses - Tic-Tac-Toe Communications Game

X's and O's is a game for two players who take turns marking the spaces in a three-by-three grid with X or O. The player who succeeds in placing three of their marks in a horizontal, vertical, or diagonal row is the winner.

Split section up into groups of two individuals. Each Individual is given this laminated sheet and a radio.

Each Individual introduces themselves to the other team using the phonetic alphabet and agree who will be X and who will be O . E.g. “My name is Katie – **K**ilo, **A**lpha, **T**ango, **I**ndia, **E**cho , Katie, I will be X **O**ver”.

Saying “**O**ver” when you are finished speaking is important so that the other side know you are finished speaking.
